1) **welcome to new members**

2) **pool heater**

We are aiming to have the heaters installed by September but the schedule is dependent on availability of supplies and labor and county permitting processes.

3) **wifi and food delivery address**

the address for food delivery services is posted outside the bathhouse (near the water fountain). The PHRA wifi code is also posted there. Please do not stream videos or otherwise use a lot of bandwidth as our pool management team also needs connectivity to check members in.

4) **party policy**

5) **tennis courts**

6) **adult swim/lap lanes**

Lap lane only swim will start June 12 from 10:00-11:00am on Saturday and Sundays on a first-come, first-served basis. In addition, two lap lanes will be available from 11-noon on Saturdays and Sundays by reservation. Lap lanes will be unavailable on holidays and weekends from noon to closing, in order to provide more space during peak usage. The board will evaluate weekend capacity and revisit lap lane availability next month.

6) **4th of July party**

We are having our 4th of July party this year and will be looking for volunteers to help out. As in the past the association will be providing hamburgers, hot dogs and paper supplies and members bring a variety of sides to be shared. Be on the look out for more details in the next two weeks.
